August 17 Late Registration Acellus Update Lunch Pick Up Google Email & Classroom	Families who attended in person registration during 8/10 - 8/14: 1. Waipahu Intermediate was given access to Acellus on Friday 8/14. Please expect an email no later than 8/21 with your child's login information. Students may begin in Acellus Academy as soon as they receive their login. 2. Please login and activate your <u>google email</u> AND <u>google classroom</u> accounts. A sheet with your child's login and password was given to you at registration. Families must attend an in-person registration during the week of 8/24, in the evenings, starting at 6:00 pm in the WIS cafeteria. Our staff will be calling you with your appointed day to attend. <u>If you do not attend your registration, your next opportunity to register will be during the week of September 7, 2020.</u> 2. Please pay close attention to the following protocols as we strive to create a safe environment for everyone: Registration will take place in our school cafeteria. Please adhere to the following protocols as we strive to promote a safe space for all: ● <u>All persons entering WIS must be wearing a face mask and/or face shield at all times.</u> ● Everyone in the same session will be registered at the same time. ○ <u>Plan to arrive at Waipahu Intermediate at least 30 minutes before your session start time.</u> ○ As you arrive, please pay your child's fees before

	entering the cafeteria. ○ Have your child(ren) take their student ID photo ○ Choose a seat in front of any available packet. Once you have chosen your seat, do not change seats or roam around. ○ Fill out forms in your packet and wait for the presentation to begin. Failure to complete any form during registration may result in denial of your child's registration. ● <u>Bring your own pens to write with.</u> Black / Blue ink only. ● Do not bring your entire family. <u>Only ONE legal parent/guardian (w/ photo ID) and the student(s) signing up for distance learning should come to registration!</u> ● Bring cash in small denominations as student dues will be collected on this day (\$15). This is a mandatory fee set by the State and must be paid. 8th graders who have not paid their student fees from the 19-20 school year must pay these in full along with current school year fees before being allowed to register for distance learning. Optional fees collected will be for the school yearbook (\$30) and initial meal account deposit (\$25). <u>ONLY CASH will be accepted for all fees.</u> ● Turn in your forms and exit only when your row has been excused. November 9, 2020	Aloha e Stay at Home Learning Families (Acellus), Please be advised: Currently Waipahu Intermediate has two learning tracks: 1) Distance Learning (DL) and 2) Stay At Home Learning (SAHL). While there has been no decision yet, the intention of the Hawaii Department of Education for 3rd Quarter (starting Jan 5, 2021) is to transition DL students to an In-Person/Distance "BLENDED" learning environment. <u>This means DL students will be expected to attend school in-person (on-campus) with their peers and teachers on some days AND online on other days.</u> If DL students are brought back to campus in a blended model, students in SAHL will remain on Acellus and remain at home. The open window for families to request to exit SAHL and enter DL is November 9, 2020 though December 4, 2020. If you wish to remove your child from Acellus, you must call our front office (307-9000) and speak with your child's counselor. If you request to remove your child from SAHL (Acellus), please understand: • Once you exit your child from Acellus they will not be allowed to return to Acellus.

	• When the HDOE decides it is safe to return to campus, your child must do so. • Students, whose requests have been approved, will finish the 2nd Quarter in Acellus then transition to DL/Blended Learning on Jan 5, 2021. • Students will not be given an opportunity to choose their elective and will be placed in an elective based on available space to ensure social distancing when students return to campus. • Transitioning to DL learning may present issues because of differences in curriculum pacing between Acellus and WIS curriculums. Thus, your child(ren) may have difficulty transitioning and their grades may be negatively impacted. If you have any further questions or concerns regarding this letter, please contact your child's counselor.
